YEAR OF ST JOSEPH: In a new Apostolic Letter entitled *Patris corde* ("With a Father's Heart"), Pope Francis describes Saint Joseph as a beloved father, a tender and loving father, an obedient father, an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows.

The Letter marks the 150th anniversary of Blessed Pope Pius IX's declaration of St Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To celebrate the anniversary, Pope Francis has proclaimed a special "Year of St Joseph," beginning on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception 2020 and extending to the same feast in 2021. Pope Francis.

Only stewards to sign people in on the paper work and do not allow parishioners to sign themselves in as sharing pens etc is a main transmission contact- even if they have sanitised their hands the next person touching the pen is at risk from contamination
